## **CES Dress and Grooming Expectations**

- b. Be neat and clean. Sloppy, overly casual, ragged, or extreme clothing is not acceptable.

### **2. Grooming:**

- a. Hair should be clean, neat, modest, and avoid extremes in styles and colors.
- b. Men's hair should be [neatly trimmed](#). Men should be clean shaven. If worn, mustaches should be neatly trimmed.

## PROCESS ON HOW TO GET A YSA CARD

The steps are as follows:

1. *YSA obtains Endorsement Form* (online at <https://seasidersports.byuh.edu/> or hard copies are available at the Intramural's office in McKay Gym #120 or in the offices at the CAC #226 as well as the aloha center information desk.
2. *YSA signs commitment.*
3. *A member of the Bishopric reviews the commitment and signs the form.*
4. *YSA brings Endorsement Form to our office in the CAC #226.*
5. *Our office will contact the Bishopric to verify the information on the Endorsement Form. (This is to guard against the rare person who may forge a signature.)*
6. *Our office will notify the YSA to go to the Aloha Center Information desk to get the YSA Card :*
  1. *Be in Standard*
  2. *Present a legal Identification card,*
  3. *Pay the \$10.00 fee*
  4. *Sign a waiver*
7. *Aloha Center Information desk issues the card, which is good for one year.*
